

Landscape Committee Update September 2023

Traffic Circle Landscaping

The town center traffic circle will be refurbished this fall beginning with the removal of the diseased roses. Those roses will be removed well in advance of the remainder of the project in order to treat the soil for the mites and let it rest before new plants are installed.

Later this fall when the soil has cooled, the beds in the outer ring of the circle (where the roses are located) will be completely relandscaped. All existing shrubs will be removed and new plants will be installed. The shrubs in the inner circle where there is a low brick wall will be repaired and maintained to provide a consistent and attractive hedge.

The center bricked area where the dolphin is currently located will also be completely relandscaped. The dolphin will be removed and replaced with a tall holly bush as the new focal point. Shrubs will also be planted around the base of the holly.

Seasonal Flowers

We are working with US Lawns to transition away from planting seasonal flowers each spring and fall and replacing them with flowering shrubs and perennial grass. That transition will begin this fall. You will see liriope being planted in a number of areas along with the seasonal pansies and snapdragons. Next spring we plan to install drift roses and azaleas in areas where we previously planted annual flowers. The liriope we plant this fall will remain in those areas as well. Due to increasingly hot summers, lack of irrigation in some areas, increasing cost of annual flowers, and abundant wildlife (deer and rabbits), we feel this change will provide a more consistent and attractive appearance throughout the year.

Planning for the Future

As soon as the West Neck road project is complete, we will need to begin working on new landscaping for our main entrance. In the interim we will be researching options for that space and obtaining designs and proposals.

Plantings in the front of the Village Hall also need to be refreshed. Shrubs in that area have aged well beyond their lifecycle. The timing of that initiative will be somewhat dependent on when the main entrance project can be scheduled due to budgets and resources. Again, we will be planning for this project in order to be prepared for either scenario in 2024.


