

Athletic shoes that don't have any material separation or holes in them still have enough use to be worn by others. When you give your reusable athletic shoes to GotSneakers, they're

sorted according to condition, size, and style. Then, they're packed for distribution across the globe. You may think that your used, unwearable athletic shoes are too gross to be worth recycling. Instead of throwing them away, you can send them to GotSneakers to be recycled. The athletic shoes are stripped apart, and the materials are separated for reuse. For instance, the outsole's ground rubber can be used for baseball, football and soccer fields. The midsole's ground foam can be used to resurface basketball and tennis courts as well as playgrounds. The upper fabric can be used to pad the underneath side of hardwood flooring.

Simply deposit your sneakers in the box at the Village Hall and WNEC will do the rest!
