Tip: When using Safari to surf the web, use "Reader" to eliminate ads


and distractions when reading a web page.



The athletic shoes are stripped apart, and the materials are separated for reuse. For instance, the outsole's ground rubber can be used for baseball, football and soccer fields. The midsole's ground foam can be used to resurface basketball and tennis courts as well as playgrounds. The upper fabric can be used to pad the underneath side of hardwood flooring.


