Recycling is part of the Virginia Beach lifestyle, but change is coming! The City's recycling contract with Tidewater Fibre Corp. (TFC Recycling) expires in June 2024. In the fall, City leaders asked residents what they wanted the future recycling program to look like.

From Oct. 2 to Nov. 17, 2023, 9,948 Virginia Beach residents completed the State of Recycling Survey on SpeakUpVB.com. Results from the survey were presented to City Council on Feb. 20 for consideration in the proposed FY24-25 budget.
