



How to: Keyboard Shortcuts

It's easy to create a keyboard shortcut that expands into a phrase, such as, omw for On My Way Home. It's useful for an address, or a favorite icon. More examples in the screen shot.

How to:

1-Go to Settings>General>Keyboard>Text Replacement. 2-Click the plus (+) icon at the top right to enter a phrase

3-Type a shortcut

4-Click "Save" top right.

Examples:

A Phrase: Type "your name, address, city, state, zip".

A Shortcut: Type your house number

Example: write an email, to sign it, type your house number.

Could be a word which spell check substitutes for another, ie bear for bare.

Phrase: bare Shortcut: bare
