The Pool Will Open Thursday 5/2

If you read the eNews Special Edition last week, you were informed about the delay in opening and what actions we were taking to try and remove the staining that had occurred in the plaster surface. We worked through the process of draining the pool and acid washing the entire pool surface. That was followed up immediately by a low-pressure power washing. We repeated the process in some areas up to five times. The team doing the work invested 44 man hours over 3 days. The result is that we were able to remove nearly all the staining on the pool walls, and nearly all the staining in the shallow entry area. However, the pool floor was repeatedly treated, and we only removed about 70% of the affected areas. The only permanent remedy is to have that surface recoated. We will address that with the company that did the resurfacing in late 2022. If we try to accomplish that during pool season, it will cause an extended closure. That's really not a viable option. So, for this season we're going to have to live with the slight staining. The City Health Department inspectors were

here today. They took multiple water readings and examined the pool in detail. The pool is safe to use. The staining is not causing any kind of health issue. We were issued an opening permit and inspection report.

Because we put all new water in the pool, the temperature is currently 76 degrees. By next week we'll have it in the proper range.
