

### Village Hall Refurbishment Ad Hoc Committee

At the May 15<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting, a new Committee was approved for the purpose of improving the appearance of the Village Hall facility (Village Hall Refurbishment Ad Hoc Committee). Since that approval, community members have stepped forward to volunteer and the group is now actively working on the initial steps and planning.

One of the first tasks that has been identified is to organize all Village Hall storage spaces in preparation for upcoming changes. This includes all closets, kitchen cabinets, credenzas, etc. To achieve this goal we need your help.

Any resident, group, committee or club who has items stored in the Village Hall is being asked to organize and identify your items no later than Thursday, June 27th. This includes securing the items and marking them with the group/club name, a contact name, and a contact phone number. For instance, if you have items in a cabinet in the kitchen, please organize those items and post a sign on the inside of the cabinet door noting the club/group name as well as the group's contact name and phone number.

In consideration of scheduled special events, we ask that all cleanup be completed Monday through Thursday.

After June 27<sup>th</sup>, all remaining items in stored spaces not identified as noted above will be removed from the facility.
