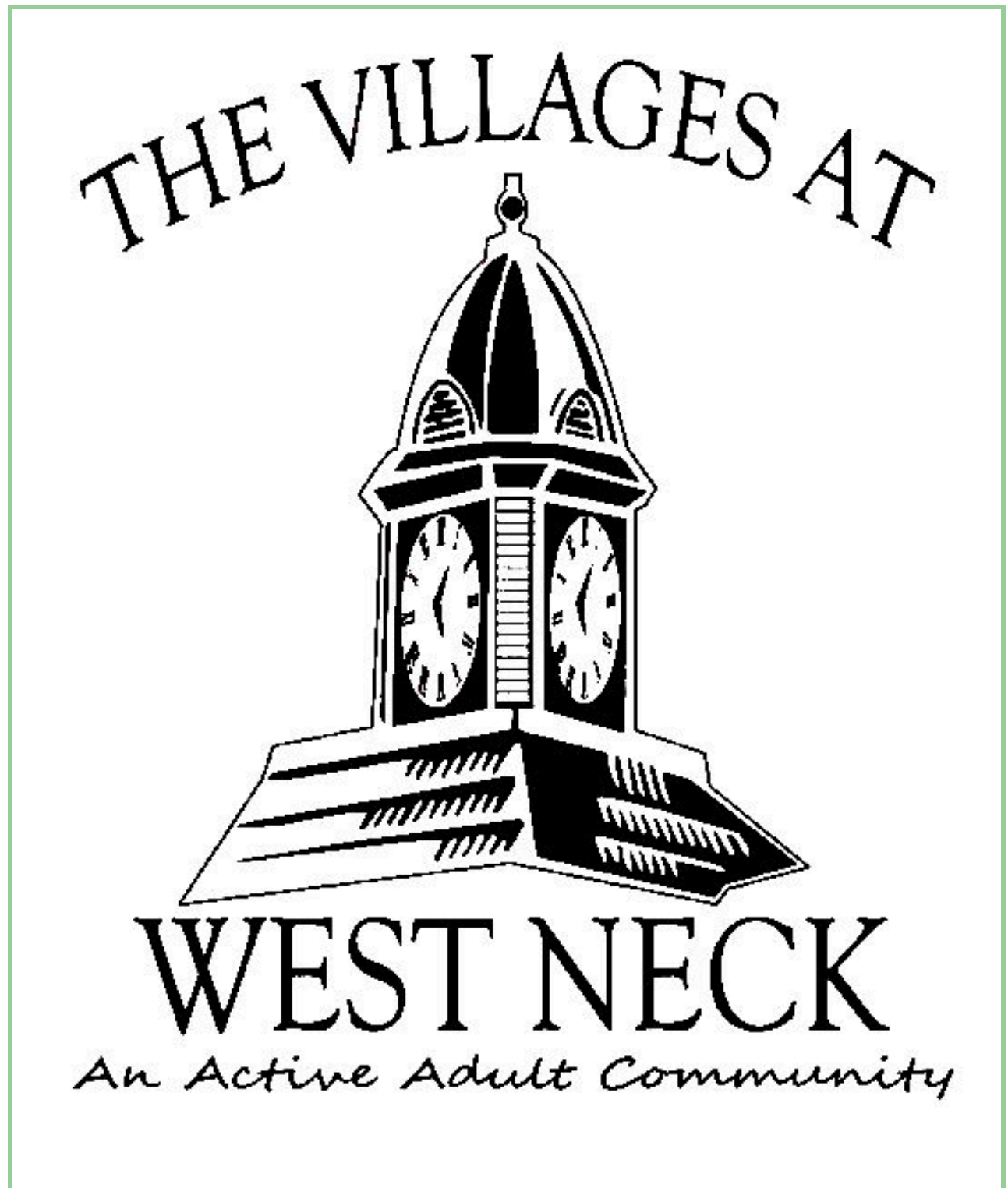

WELL RECEIVED, WELL ATTENDED & WELL DONE!!

Captain Lyndee Tripp, Nationally Registered Paramedic (NRP) and Certified Community Paramedic (CP-C) and a member of Virginia Beach Rescue, Emergency Medical Services conducted an informational program presentation on July 11 at the Village Hall. She was joined by Kelly Lee who is the Aging-in-Place Program Manager for the Virginia Beach Department of Public Health. The topics included: First Aid refresher, Automated External Defibrillator (AED) how-to's; Do's & Don'ts for seniors regarding trip & fall issues and a refresher on CardioPulmonary Resuscitation (CPR).

This program was coordinated by West Neck Learning Committee (WNLC) member Marlee Porter. Lite refreshments were provided for everyone. Over 60 homeowners / residents attended.



The presenters also provided handouts for all attendees. Brochures on "What You Can Do To Prevent Falls" and "Check for Safety – A Home Fall Prevention Checklist For Older Adults" along with a one-page "Medication Safety for Older Adults". Extra copies of these three handouts are in the library at the Village Hall. Please help yourself (first come first serve).

Note: for those who may be interested, there are Free CPR / Stop-the-Bleed Classes offered by the Virginia Beach Volunteer Rescue Squad (VBVRS). These classes run from 9:00am to 12:00pm and are all held at VBVRS Station 8 (757-333-3365). The station is located at 1243 Bayne Drive in Virginia Beach.

What's Euchre? It's a little like bridge or hearts but much easier to learn in a few sessions. Ours is a friendly, fun-oriented, informal game and we'll help you every step of the way.

Euchre is a card game that uses only the cards nine through ace and the Jacks are the most important card. Once trump is decided per hand, then the "right bower" is the Jack of Trump and the "left bower" is the other Jack of the same color. It is also a trump card. The Jacks are the highest cards in the hand. (Example: If Hearts are trump, then the Jack of Hearts is the Right Bower and the Jack of Diamonds is the Left Bower).

These guidelines are for **all West Neck residents** who wish to submit an announcement for publication in the weekly Tuesday eNews.

All requests for publication shall be directed to the dedicated email address:
westnecknotices@gmail.com

eNews submission dates for Tuesday eNews publication:

- Submission deadline will be the prior Wednesday at noon.
- Submissions received after this Wednesday deadline may result in your flyer not being published or published a week later if it is still within your event timeframe.

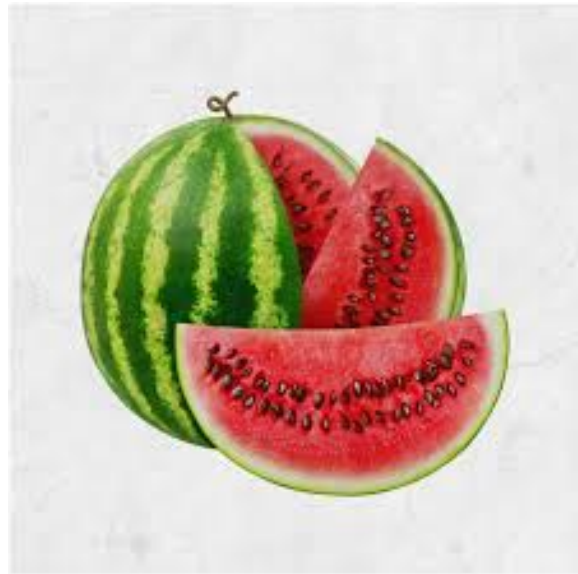
Event flyer submission:

- **Provide a .pdf (preferred format) or .jpeg flyer**

Use the **SUBJECT LINE of your email** to indicate the edition date and your event date and name, such as:
 - **10/18/23 edition for 10/20/23 (your event name)**
- If your event is not date specific (i.e. monthly fitness calendars), indicate your event in this manner:
 - **03/28/23 edition for 04/00/23 (your event name)**
- If you are submitting a flyer that has been updated or changed in any manner, **alert the editors** when submitting and **rename the flyer** for clarity so that it will not be confused with a previous flyer such as:
 - **07/11/23 edition for 07/20/23 CORRECTED (your event name)**
- If your event is being sponsored by a committee/club (ex: Social Committee, Learning Committee, etc.), the sponsoring name must appear on the flyer.
- You will need to submit each week that you want to continue a reminder for the event.
