

## THIS WEEK IN HISTORY


John Adams and Thomas Jefferson died on the same day, **July 4, 1826**. Both were old men—Adams was 90, and Jefferson was 83—and both were ill, though Adams had been in comparatively robust health until just a few months earlier and Jefferson had been ill for an extended period. Though the nation's second and third presidents were friends at the time of their deaths, they had been politically estranged for eleven years after the presidential election of 1800. Jefferson, along with James Madison, formed the Democratic-Party while Adams was a Federalist. Adams wrote a letter to Jefferson on January 1, 1812, the first of many that renewed their friendship that lasted until their deaths.

Daniel Webster's eulogy for Adams and Jefferson spoke to a point that many people believed: that something other than coincidence was involved.

"The concurrence of their death on the anniversary of Independence has naturally awakened stronger emotions," Webster said. "It cannot but seem striking and extraordinary, that these two should live to see the fiftieth year from the date of that act, that they should complete that year, and that then, on the day which had fast linked forever their own fame with their country's glory, the heavens should open to receive them both at once."

"As their lives themselves were the gifts of Providence, who is not willing to recognize in their happy termination, as well as in their long continuance, proofs that our country and its benefactors are objects of His care?"



These guidelines are for **all West Neck residents** who wish to submit an announcement for publication in the weekly Tuesday eNews.

All requests for publication shall be directed to the dedicated email address: westnecknotices@gmail.com

eNews submission dates for Tuesday eNews publication:

- Submission deadline will be the prior Wednesday at noon.
- Submissions received after this Wednesday deadline may result in your flyer not being published or published a week later if it is still within your event timeframe.

#### Event flyer submission:

Provide a .pdf (preferred format) or .jpeg flyer

Use the **SUBJECT LINE of your email** to indicate the edition date and your event date and name, such as:

- 10/18/23 edition for 10/20/23 (your event name)
- If your event is not date specific (i.e. monthly fitness calendars), indicate your event in this manner:
  - 03/28/23 edition for 04/00/23 (your event name)
- If you are submitting a flyer that has been updated or changed in any manner, <u>alert the editors</u> when submitting and <u>rename the flyer</u> for clarity so that it will not be confused with a previous flyer such as:
  - 07/11/23 edition for 07/20/23 CORRECTED (your event name)
- If your event is being sponsored by a committee/club (ex: Social Committee, Learning Committee, etc.), the sponsoring name must appear on the flyer.
- You will need to submit each week that you want to continue a reminder for the event.
