Know if you live in a district that will vote for City Council in November 2024

Early voting starts Sept. 20 for this fall's election. Virginia Beach has 10 local election districts, and districts 1, 3, 5, 7 and 8 have candidates running for City Council this year.

If you live in one of those districts, you'll vote for your council candidate of choice. If you don't live in one of those districts, you won't vote for a district representative candidate this year, but everyone will vote for a mayoral candidate.

The department hosted two summer camps — Camp Connect and Camp Blue Line — to connect with Virginia Beach youth.

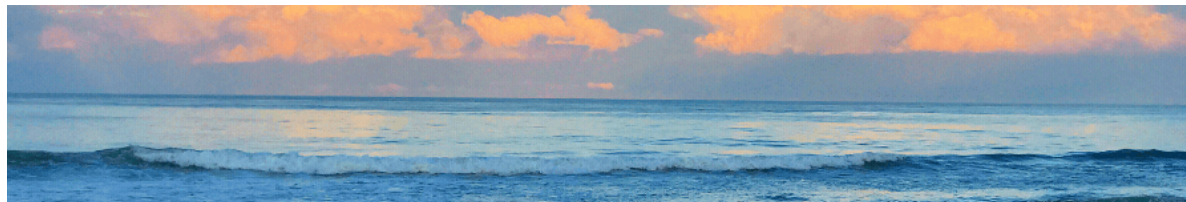
