

## Compassion and Choices (C&C) Medical Aid in Dying

### Informational presentation with Q&A

(light refreshments will be available)

Medical aid in dying, an option for mentally capable, terminally ill adults to peacefully end unbearable suffering, is supported by a wide variety of Virginians regardless of political affiliation, religion, age, race, location, population density, voters vs non-voters, gender identify, education and income. Medical aid in dying is currently authorized in 11 jurisdictions. They include Oregon, Washington, Montana, Vermont, California, Colorado, Washington DC, Hawaii, New Jersey, Maine and New Mexico.

Compassion and Choices supports medical aid in dying legislation that may pass in Virginia in the near future. Part of their mission is to educate the public about that legislation and end-of-life matters. Medical Aid in Dying is an end-of-life option that allows terminally ill adults to request, obtain and - should they choose - take medications to die peacefully in their sleep if suffering becomes unbearable. Medical Aid in Dying is NOT suicide or assisted suicide nor physician-assisted suicide and is not euthanasia.

#### The Villages at West Neck eNews Submission Guidelines

These guidelines are for **all West Neck residents** who wish to submit an announcement for publication in the weekly Tuesday eNews.

All requests for publication shall be directed to the dedicated email address: westnecknotices@gmail.com

eNews submission dates for Tuesday eNews publication:

- Submission deadline will be the prior Wednesday at noon.
- Submissions received after this Wednesday deadline may result in your flyer not being published or published a week later if it is still within your event timeframe.

#### Event flyer submission:

Provide a .pdf (preferred format) or .jpeg flyer

Use the **SUBJECT LINE of your email** to indicate the edition date and your event date and name, such as:

- 10/18/23 edition for 10/20/23 (your event name)
- If your event is not date specific (i.e. monthly fitness calendars), indicate your event in this manner:
  - 03/28/23 edition for 04/00/23 (your event name)
- If you are submitting a flyer that has been updated or changed in any manner, <u>alert the editors</u> when submitting and <u>rename the flyer</u> for clarity so that it will not be confused with a previous flyer such as:
  - 07/11/23 edition for 07/20/23 CORRECTED (your event name)
- If your event is being sponsored by a committee/club (ex: Social Committee, Learning Committee, etc.), the sponsoring name must appear on the flyer.
- You will need to submit each week that you want to continue a reminder for the event.
