



## **Voters will choose their candidates of choice for federal and local elections.**

The first day of in-person early voting is Friday, Sept. 20. Polls will be open Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., at the Voter Registrar's Office, [2449 Princess Anne Road](#). Voters will select their chosen candidate for federal and local elections.

Virginia Beach has 10 local election districts, and districts 1, 3, 5, 7 and 8 have candidates running for City Council this year. If you live in one of those districts, you'll vote for your council candidate of choice. If you don't live in one of those districts, you won't vote for a district representative candidate this year, but everyone will vote for a mayoral candidate. Knowing what district you live in is important.

Saturday voting will be available starting Oct. 26 and satellite voting locations will open. The last day to vote early is Saturday, Nov. 2. Read more about voter information, looking up your district, registering and important voting dates and deadlines.

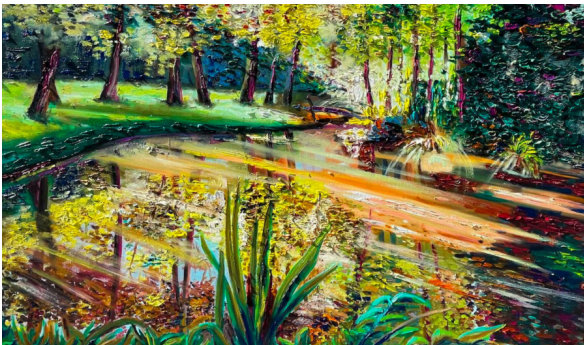
